Just by the announcement of the intention to implement ENOS Marcus Hauck recognized high appreciation by his staff. Finally they daily struggle the danger to lose divers by currents. No wonder that the enthusiasm was extremely high when Karl Hansmann, owner of manufacturer Seareq and inventor of ENOS-System, trained them.
